FCAV is the peak body for foster care in Victoria. We champion carers and support their role to provide the best possible experiences for children and young people in care, assisting them to reach their full potential.



CARER SUPPORT

The FCAV provides a range of foster care specific supports and services. The **Carer Support Team** includes carer advocates who provide information and advice to foster carers about navigating the home-based care system including:

- support and advocacy for foster carers involved in a Client Incident Management System (CIMS).
- Liaison with foster carer's agency, when necessary, to advocate for foster carers.
- Liaison with Department and other key stakeholders for individual advocacy.

The Carer Assistance Program supports carers' mental health and wellbeing through therapeutic short-term intervention delivered one-to-one, as couples or in group therapeutic settings.

The FCAV Learning and Development Program provides opportunities for carer peer support, forums and self care awareness, as well as facilitating sessions through Victoria's Carer KaFE training program on specialised topics for carer education.

Offering specialised information on the full carer experience including placement support, legislative and policy implementation, financial and process information.
